

NEVADA UTAH CONFERENCE PRESIDENT

On Wednesday, May 4, Leon Brown, Sr., accepted the call to serve as the new president of the Nevada-Utah Conference. The Nevada-Utah Conference's Presidential Search Committee voted to extend him the invitation on Monday, May 2.

Brown has served as the NCC's African American ministries coordinator, urban ministries director, men's ministries coordinator, and prison ministries coordinator

since March 5, 2014. Before that, he served as senior pastor of the Sacramento Capitol City church from 2012-2014, pastor of the Fairfield Community church from 2006-2012, and pastor of the Pittsburg church from 1998-2006. Prior to pastoral ministry, he worked for a decade in business and education.

Born in Jamaica, Brown grew up in Rochester, New York, and graduated from Pine Forge Academy. A firm believer in higher education, he graduated with a double major in theology and business from Oakwood University, and then went on to earn a Master of Divinity and a Master of Business Administration at Andrews University. He also holds a Doctor of Ministry from San Francisco Theological Seminary.

Brown has been married for 28 years to Julie Albritton, who works as a program manager for the San Joaquin County Office of Education. They have two adult sons—Leon, II, a graduate of Oakwood University, and Lawrence, who will soon begin his third year of medical school at Meharry Medical College in Tennessee. In his spare time, Brown enjoys various forms of physical exercise and listening to music.

He is looking forward to this next stage of his life. "When I became a pastor, I surrendered my heart and mind to God," said Brown. "Throughout the years, Julie and I have learned that our commitment to God means that we must always be open to follow God's will wherever He leads us. I am looking forward to seeing how God is going to lead us in Nevada and Utah."

NUC Treasurer Doug Reeves shared "We are excited about the opportunity to work with Elder Leon Brown. We have heard great things about him and look forward to his leadership in our conference."


